These pictures were taken at the Gathering of The Orange in LaPorte IN. This show commemorated the 100th anniversary of the beginning of Allis-Chalmers tractor production.

The show was held at the LaPorte County Fairgrounds which is also the home to the new Allis-Chalmers Rumley Museum. LaPorte was home to an Allis-Chalmers plant where 'All Crop' combines as well as hay and forage equipment were built along with some other products.

The museum is just completing the first stage and is looking for donations of both money and artifacts. Unfortunately the County and the City do not value the heritage of both Rumley and later Allis-Chalmers (which weremajor employers for many decades) enough to contribute to the museums success.

We stopped to see a nice beach and a large rock outcrop called "Goat Rock" and came across this old piece of machinery. Although it is not a piece of old Allis machinery, I think these photos are worth sharing none the less.







My brief research has identified the remains of this machine as a P&H Model 206 Corduroy Power Shovel from the 1920's. The company was located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, USA and still exists in some form today and produces mining equipment. This model had a ¼ cubic yard dipper bucket.


